# STATES:

1) The auxiliary gym will be our bullpen for all wrestlers. The ONLY wrestlers that are permitted on the main gym floor are "on deck" and "In the hole" wrestlers. Everyone else should remain in the bullpen.

2) It is the coaches responsibility to manage and watch your wrestlers. If you have a wrestler(s) in the bullpen you must have a coach in the bullpen with them.

3) Only coaches with an approved OYWA or USA Wrestling background passes will be allowed on the floor. You MUST have it displayed at all times. If you do not have one you will not be permitted on the floor. There are NO exceptions

### Gate Admission

- There is NO RE ENTRY. If someone leaves and decides to come back they will need to pay to reenter.
- There is no food or coolers allowed past the main gate. If someone brings a cooler or food they will NOT be permitted in. If someone is caught with outside food they will be asked to leave.
- There is no smoking anywhere on school grounds, if caught you will be removed.
- Any parent or non coach without the approved OYWA or USA Wrestling background pass caught anywhere on the floor will be removed from the building.
- There is no standing along the railing, it prevents the spectators in the bleachers from watching their wrestler compete.

## FROM OYWA and REFEREE'S:

The referee will supervise the weigh-in.

- Contestants can not leave the weigh-in area.
- All contestants must weigh in wearing a legal uniform with suitable undergarments. Female contestants shall wear equipment to minimize the risk of exposure.
- A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times to make weight. If they miss weight, the contestant shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight. Dehydration is prohibited.
- Contestants may weigh-in with socks on, but they can not be removed as means for weight reduction.
- Any special accommodation letter and all special equipment must be brought to weigh-in for inspection.
- Mouthpieces are required if the contestant wears braces.
- Full length leg/arm sleeves are not permitted.

The referee or a designated health physician shall supervise Health Inspection (the official has final authority).

- A signed physician note <u>must be on the NFHS approved skin</u> form and be present in the weigh-in room when requested. The form is valid 10 days from the date of exam. Forms outside of this 10 day window are not acceptable for contagious conditions (Skin forms diagnosing non contagious skin conditions are valid the entire season).
- Photocopies, a letter from a physician, or electronic copies on an electronic device are not accepted.

### Match length

3 one (1) minute periods

Overtime: The overtime period is one one-minute sudden victory period followed by a 30-second period if necessary. In the ultimate tie breaker the person who scores first in the regulation match has choice and their choice is top or bottom. If the wrestler was penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct, choice is offered to the opponent.

Please make sure ALL coaches on the floor possess the OYWA / USA Wrestling background passes this week.

- They must be wearing them visible at all times in the weigh-in area and on the wrestling floor.
- The only exception will be the USA Wrestling pass. Those must also be printed and worn visible at all times.

• During tournament competition, a maximum of two (2) coaches will be permitted in the chairs (many of our coaches are also parents so 1 child is also permitted).
